

Died, at 8:20 a. m., Monday, April 22, 1894, at the residence of his son, Mr. W. A. Gahlenbeck, in this city, Mr. August Gahlenbeck, at the age of 74. The deceased first came to Pensacola in 1882. His wife and one son died during the yellow fever epidemic of that year and he returned to Philadelphia. He returned in 1888 and resided here continuously until his death.
