DAVID C. BARFIELD

Funeral services for David Coulson Barfield Sr., 51, certified public accountant and former school teacher who died Monday morning in a local hospital, will be held at 9 a.m. Wednesday in Waters & Hibbert Chapel. Burial will be in St. John's Cemetery.

Mr. Barfield formerly taught at Pensacola High School and Pensacola Junior College.

Mr. Barfield was born in Louisville, Ky., but moved with his family to Charleston, S. C., when a child. He was the first honor graduate of Charleston High School, having made a record which has never been topped in that school. He obtained an AB degree from the College of Charleston and later took his apprenticeship in accounting under J. M. Jordan in Jacksonville.

Moving to Pensacola in 1935, he taught two years at Pensacola High and five years in accounting in the night division of the junior college. He was in business as a CPA in the firm of Baggett & Barfield, 204 W. Chase St. He was a member of Pi Kappa Phi social fraternity and resided at Fairport Drive in Gulf Breeze.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Coulson Barfield; three sons, David Coulson Barfield Jr., Jesse Tobias Barfield and Albert Barfield; three daughters, Miss Genevieve Barfield, Mrs. Richard Bodette and Sister David Therese; and one brother, Jesse T. Barfield.

Mr. Barfield was a member of the American Institute of C.P.A. and the Florida C.P.A.
