

BALKUM DIES OF INJURIES

Laundry Employe Had Lost Arm In Machinery

J. D. "Duke" Balkum, 1111 West LaRua street, died at the Pensacola hospital early today of injuries received Monday when he became entangled in machinery at a local laundry plant.

Balkum died after his employer, George Holland, had given more than a quart of blood in a transfusion in an effort to save his life.

Balkum's right arm was torn from his body when his clothing became entangled in machinery at the Holland laundry plant. His condition had improved and attending physicians had held hope for his recovery until last night.

Funeral arrangements for Balkum will be announced later by Fisher-Pou.
