

### Death of Capt. John Pinney.

There passed from earth in this city yesterday one of Pensacola's oldest citizens, Capt. John Pinney, in the 79th year of his life. The deceased was born in Baltimore in May, 1813. From the age of 14 he followed the sea. In the year 1834 he came to Pensacola on the U. S. ship Vandalia. He married a Miss Mealy in this city in 1837. The issue to the marriage was four children, two of whom only are his immediate survivors. These are Mr. John L. Pinney, city clerk, and Miss Laura Pinney, both of this city. For some time past Captain Pinney's energies had been failing him, and a short while since, unable to leave the house, he took to his bed, gradually wasting away until death came as related. He will be buried from the residence of his son, No. 43 East Gregory street, to-day.
