

CHARLES WILLS DIES SUDDENLY

Retired Contractor Dies at Home, 227 East Intendencia; Old Resident.

Charles William Wills, 72, died suddenly at his home, 227 East Intendencia street at 7 o'clock Tuesday night. He was well known in Pensacola, having lived in the city for the last 40 years or more. Mr. Wills had not engaged in active work in the last few years, but was a prominent contractor during his younger days.

The dead man is survived by a widow, Mrs. Sarah Wills, and five children: Lillian, Richard and Charles Wills, who live at home; Mrs. Lucy Davenport, Montgomery, Ala., and Charles Wills, in the United States Army and stationed at a camp in Georgia.
