

SUDDEN DEATH

Of Mr. Henry T. Wright at the Osceola Club.

All Pensacola was shocked yesterday by the announcement that Mr. Henry T. Wright had died suddenly at the Osceola club.

Mr. Wright came down town in seeming perfect health shortly before noon and joined a number of friends at the club.

After chatting in a jocular manner about the weather he got up and walked over to get a paper to read. Suddenly he tottered and fell, death being almost instantaneous.

Mr. Wright was one of the most prominent and influential citizens of Pensacola—a man who has done great good to his fellow man, and who will be sadly missed by many whom he had befriended.

He was a member of the timber shipping firm of Wright & Whiting.

The flags in the city to-day are flying at half mast in honor to his memory.

The funeral will take place from the residence, 123 East Gregory street, at 11 o'clock to-morrow morning. Interment in St. John's cemetery.

The Citizens National bank will be closed to-morrow from 10:30 a. m. to noon, out of respect to the memory of Mr. Wright, who was one of the directors of the bank.
