

FUNERAL OF CIVIL WAR VET TUESDAY

**Elijah Powell Passes Away in
Mobile—Camp Ward No. 10
To Attend Funeral.**

The funeral of Elijah Powell, aged 67, war veteran, will be held this afternoon at 4:30 o'clock from F. R. Fox's undertaking parlor. Burial will be in St. John's cemetery. Members of Camp Ward No. 10 will attend the funeral in a body.

Mr. Powell died in Mobile Sunday night while on a visit with his daughter. He had been ill about a month. He was widely known in Pensacola and Escambia county, having lived here for many years. During the war he served in Company K Fourth Florida Infantry.

Local pallbearers will be J. Sullivan, E. Bernard, William Jack, Powell, Charles Perry, Jr., A. J. Smith and Morris Whitaker. Members of Camp Ward will act as honorary pallbearers. The deceased leaves a brother, Ben Powell, and a father-in-law, Charles Perry, at this city.
