

Death Takes Veteran Negro School Teacher

Alice S. Williams, oldest member of the Washington High school faculty died at the Pensacola hospital Sunday October 12, 1941, after a brief illness.

Funeral service will be conducted at the Mt. Zion Baptist church today at 2:30 with interment in St. John's Cemetery.

She is survived by a daughter Dorothy, librarian at Washington High school and a son Henry Garrick, employed in railway service. The entire student body, faculty and a host of friends will join the family in bereavement.

The body will lie in state at Mt. Zion Baptist church Coyle and Jackson, from 12:30 until 2:00 p.m. Rev. J. A. Leach, pastor of the church will officiate.
