Ernest Elmer Biebighauser, 87, of Pensacola, died Thursday, December 27, 2001.

Mr. Biebighauser was a native of Pensacola and had resided most of his life here. He was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church. He attended local schools and graduated from Pensacola High School. He received his associates degree from St. Bernard's College of Cullman, AL. Mr. Biebighauser served his country in the U. S. Navy during WW II. Following the war he received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Northwestern University in Evanston, IL. He was an editor with the Smithsonian Institute Press from 1953-1975.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Lucile Shows Biebighauser.
