

OBITUARY.

Died in this city at 12 m., September 25, 1891, after lingering sickness, Mrs. JEANIE C. DAVISON, aged 59 years and 10 months, the wife of Wm. H. Davison, Esq., Civil Engineer.

This estimable lady was the daughter of Judge Walker Anderson, long deceased, a Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida, and was the sister of W. E. Anderson, Esq., of this city. A native of Hillsboro, N. C., but a resident of Pensacola almost from infancy, she here made the record of a life that exemplified the loveliest Christian virtues, which combined with the graces of an amiable disposition and a cultured mind to win and retain the esteem and admiration of all who knew her. She was a communicant of Christ Church for forty-five years, and her earnest and practical piety was ever manifest in word and work. She was long the President of the Women's Auxiliary Society, and of late years her chief field of work in the service of the Master has been the city Mission of St. Katherine's Chapel on East Hill. But the time came when she could no longer go about her labor of love and good deeds, and while she bore her great suffering with admirable fortitude and Christian resignation her protracted illness became one long grief to her wide circle of attached friends. As to the bereaved husband, the afflicted relatives—who may more than refer to a sorrow too sacred for public comment or condolence? But they mourn not as those without hope, and know that their loss is her gain. The funeral was from Christ Church last evening, and she was laid to rest in the family burial ground in St John's cemetery beside the loved ones who had gone before.
