

All the patients at St. Anthony's hospital were doing well late last night; in fact, such was the case all day yesterday. At the colored hospital, however, one of the inmates is in a decidedly critical condition, and was not expected to live until this morning.

Mr. King, who conducts the National hotel on East Government street, and was taken sick with fever about ten days ago, is also in a critical condition, and may not survive. His fever last night was 106, and his pulse down to 40. Mr. King had almost entirely recovered from his illness and was on the verge of being discharged by the attending physician, but it is said that yesterday he felt so much better that he got up and drank some liquor. Of course, he was taken with a relapse, and the act of imprudence may cost him his life.
