

CAPT. POU FELL DEAD

Captain L. A. Pou, residing on Hayne street, while looking at pictures in Turton's stairway this afternoon at 2:15 o'clock, suddenly fell over, and friends who were near him quickly raised the prostrate man and carried him to the Hargis pharmacy, where he expired within a few moments.

Captain Pou was a familiar figure on the streets of this city, where for many years he had resided. He was subject to heart trouble and this is said to have been the contributing cause of the sudden death.

He has many relatives in Pensacola, being an uncle to Frank Pou, the undertaker, and is also related to County Clerk A. M. McMillan, N. C. McMillan and Mrs. M. P. Gould. A brother residing in Montgomery and three married sisters also survive him. Many people were shocked to hear of his death.

The old gentleman died just as THE NEWS was going to press and it was impossible to secure further details for this issue. He was about 63 years of age, and served through the civil war as captain.

Funeral arrangements will be perfected this afternoon and interment will probably occur Friday.
