

Col. Hugh Edward Jordan

Funeral for Col. Hugh Edward Jordan, 51, of 405 N. 16th Ave., who died Sunday, will be at 2:30 p.m. Wednesday in the East Hill Baptist Church with the Rev. Joseph P. DuBose officiating.

Colonel Jordan was a career officer in the United States Army with service in World War II and the Korean War. He was awarded the Legion of Merit by President Johnson for outstanding service in personnel evaluation of Middle East forces during the past year.

He was a member of the East Hill Baptist Church and was a 32nd Degree Mason.
