

Local Soldier Killed in Crash

Stanley Edward Racine Dies in Transport

Stanley Edward Racine, 21, 907 West Garden street, was one of 17 soldiers killed when a huge Army transport plane crashed into a mountain near Peru, Mass., Saturday night.

Army authorities notified Racine's mother, Mrs. A. M. Young, yesterday that her son, a United States Army private of the 502nd Parachute Infantry, Fort Benning Ga., was aboard the plane which burst into flames after it struck the mountain.

The plane was on a routine mission out of Pope field, Fort Bragg, N. C.

The young man is survived by his mother and step-father, Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Young. The body will be shipped here where funeral services will be held. Announcements will be made later.
