

OWEN M. "TOBY" WARD

Owen M. "Toby" Ward, 76, of Pensacola, died at home Saturday, January 20, 2001 of cancer. He fought a good fight.

Toby was born January 19, 1925 in San Diego, Calif. He moved to Pensacola shortly thereafter. He graduated from Pensacola High School in 1942. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy. He graduated



from Auburn University with a degree in mechanical engineering. He was a member of Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity. Upon graduation, he worked in the family tugboat business, A.P. Ward & Son.
