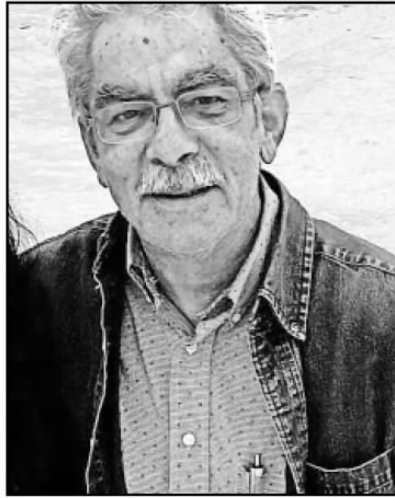


**HALCOTT FREDRICK
